We are inviting Adams Lake Indian Band members between the ages of 19 to 26 to submit their expression of interest for the position of Camp Assistant. This will be a short-term contract position for the dates of August 6 to August 20 (with 4 positions available).

Cultural camp is an opportunity to spend time on the land where you will gain valuable traditional knowledge and experience supporting youth to do the same. This is your chance to reconnect with Secwépemc culture, the land, and your spirit.

Camp assistants will provide assistance to the camp directors as required. Duties will include, but are not limited to the following:

- Supervision of campers to ensure their safety and well-being at all times.
- Assist in the facilitation of camp activities
- Assist in set up and takedown of camp
- Provide guidance and support of campers as needed
- Reinforce camp rules,
- Encourage campers to participate in camp activities
