



Nusery/Kindergarten Immersion Program





Primary Immersion Program (Grades 1 to 4)

Secwepemcstin is taught by total immersion in the primary program. During this stage of language immersion children are expected to converse in the Secwepemc. All courses are conducted in the Secwepemc language, including core content courses of Math, Language Arts and Science.

Intermediate Program (Grades 5 to 7)

The intermediate curriculum and instruction follows the Chief Atahm School Vision Statement.

Program Includes:
