Adams Lake Response to Covid 19

Pandemic Emergency

Submitted by Health & Wellness Department

Careful planning and organization of workflow are currently taking place as we begin to slowly and thoughtfully open things up at Adams Lake. Noticeable physical changes, along with new practices (such as disinfecting hands when first entering offices) will become part of the new workflow as we follow the Provincial Health Officer's guidelines as well as WorkSafe BC guidelines. Plexiglass barriers (like we see in grocery stores and retail stores) will be visible in reception areas, along with enhanced cleaning of high touch surfaces. Buildings will have occupancy capacities that vary between the office buildings at Adams Lake (based on numerous factors). Anyone who has Covid-19 symptoms is being asked not to enter office buildings (staff, or anyone seeking services), but to call instead. Booked appointments are needed, as drop ins are challenging to accommodate at this time due to occupancy limits and cleaning procedures. Physical distancing of 6 feet (2 metres) will be maintained when at all possible, inside and outside of buildings. Refreshments such as tea and coffee will not be available in offices at

this time for office visitors. All of these measures will be in place for the next foreseeable future, as we protect the Health and Wellness of the Adams Lake community and its workers. We know that this virus is not going away anytime soon, but there are things we can do to limit its spread. We know these are challenging times to be navigating services, and they are also challenging times to be working in. We know that Patience, Kindness and Understanding goes a long way as we treat each other respectfully during these incredibly challenging times.
