Adams Lake Response to Covid 19 Pendomic Emorgonov

Pandemic Emergency

The Adams Lake Indian Band recommends that all members limit travel outside of the community at this time. This means that family and friends from other parts of the province or country should not be coming to visit you or your household at this time.

The May long weekend is approaching, and for many of us, that means traditions, travels, barbeques and the start of the summer season. However, our Provincial Health Officer, Dr. Bonnie Henry has reminded us that now is not the time to be travelling or gathering in large groups or hosting friends and family from out of town. We are still being asked to stay local and see 'fewer faces in bigger spaces' (still 6 feet apart, and outside is better). As we begin to slowly expand our social connections in Phase 2 (after the long weekend), it is important to be mindful and take note of who we interact with and where we go. Keeping a journal or writing on a calendar can be an easy way to keep track. We must remember that anyone we come into contact with also means that we are exposed to anyone they have been in contact with (that is why this virus can spread so easily). Our social bubble can become quite big without us even knowing it.

Last week Premier John Horgan announced BC's

Restart Plan that will roll out in 4 Phases. We are currently in Phase 1, and will move to Phase 2 after the May long weekend (after Dr. Bonnie Henry assesses the numbers and formally gives the go -ahead).

The BC Centre for Disease Control and the Province of BC is wanting to hear how British Columbians are doing during this Covid-19 Pandemic. There is an online survey available until May 31, and is for anyone over 18 to take. You can also call in to do the survey over the phone if you would prefer. This will provide valuable information on how people have been affected by Covid-19, and will inform decisions moving forward.

All of the Public Health Orders from Dr. Bonnie Henry, Provincial Health Officer, remain in effect at this time. We are still being asked to:

- stay home as much as possible and only go out to the grocery store when needed (and only one shopper from the household)
- you are required to stay at home if you have any Covid-19 symptoms
- only spend time with those who regularly live in your household
- maintain a physical of 2 metres between people (6 feet)
- wash your hands regularly
- cough/sneeze into your elbow
- clean high touch surfaces regularly (doorknobs, light switches, counters, bathrooms).
