## Secwepemctsín 1 Course Announcement



### An apprentice

- teacher/learner will assist in each class.
- A fluent Elder will be available on the Saturday classes to provide individual and group assistance.
  - Students are expected to teach the course to family and in community classes.
  - Games and songs will be provided for each lesson for engaging multigenerational practice.

### **Course Overview**

- Participants receive Secwepemctsín 1 resource binder with 45 lessons and audios.
- Each lesson contains about 12 vocabulary terms incorporated into sentences and mini conversations (questions and answers).
- Each lesson focusses on a theme: family, household routines, animals, etc.
- Lessons are interactive with individual and group practice activities.
- The focus is on communication: listening and speaking.
- Homework for family practice will be assigned after each lesson and is expected to be completed before each class.
- Regular informal assessments will be given to monitor student progress. However, no marks will be assigned.
- No credits will be assigned.
- Due to COVID 19, classes will be taught on an on-line platform such as Zoom. Access to Internet is required.
