ABORIGINAL LIFESKILLS FACILITATOR PROGRAM (FULL-TIME & PART-TIME)

The purpose of the 15-Week Aboriginal Life Skills Facilitator Training:

- Provide culturally-specific training (utilizing educational teaching and learning strategies) that will enhance opportunities for development of Aboriginal people
- Prepare Aboriginal people to facilitate or coordinate life skills, job readiness, cultural development, youth work, career planning, reconciliation, strategies for language teaching, leadership, supporting / tutoring, project planning, and wellness/ self-care.
- Promote self-determination and wellness for Aboriginal individuals and communities.

WHO SHOULD COME?

This program will be of interest to Aboriginal, Metis and Inuit individuals such as: support workers, program coordinators or managers, staff or individuals that have an interest in facilitating training programs for aboriginal people and communities.

Useful for any individuals who may be working with Aboriginal people, but especially beneficial for those with future in teaching, support worker, or cultural resource work.
