4. Be able to identify fish species that inhabit the Shuswap Lake System;
5. Ability to work weekends and long hours doing shift work;

- Installation and operation of an adult salmon fish fence to count and assess salmon returns; able to lift 40 to 50lbs
- Frequent foot surveys of the stream to count and assess salmon returns
- Collect biological samples from salmon carcasses (lengths, sex, scales, otoliths)
- Detailed data collection and recording; take clear, concise, correct notes
- Be on time and reliable, willingness to learn
- Maintaining open communication on project and follow directions
- Work independently and as a good team member
- Coming to work with necessary work clothes and field gear
- Be able to follow safety protocol
- Be able to communicate effectively with the public
