NATURE & SCOPE OF WORK:

The Adams Lake Indian Band is currently seeking a knowledgeable and supportive professional to join their team as a Social Worker. Reporting to and under the direction of the Director of Health and Wellness/designate; the Social Worker is responsible for providing community based social services to identified groups, individuals, and families within applicable legislation to protect and improve the social well-being and functioning of families and individuals.

POSITION TASKS:

- Performs all duties and responsibilities in accordance with Adams Lake Indian Band policies and procedures
- Provide child protection, within applicable legislation, to prevent children from suffering emotional, sexual, physical and/or other types of abuse and neglect
- Provide referrals to mental health services
- Conduct needs and risk assessment
- Provide community development services to improve social functioning, internally and externally.
- Participates in the development of strategic plans for community development and program management
- Provides life skills support to individuals and families
- Coordinates and facilitates programs and resources to build capacity
- Works in conjunction with other departments in the delivery of services
- Develops, maintains accurate health records, statistics, and reports in the Mustimuhw Health Information System
- Promotes the Sexqeltqin and Nexe7yelst Health Centres activities
