



21st Annual CP Holiday Train 2019

The Canadian Pacific (CP) Railway initiative will bring a train, decked out in holiday lights and decorations, across the country. Following CP's tracks west to Vancouver, BC. Musical performance by Terri Clark and another musician to be announced later.

Terri Clark, originally from Medicine Hat, Alberta, is a three time JUNO Award winner. She's also the only Canadian female named as a member of the legendary Grand Ole Opry. Clark has received 19 CCMA Awards and is a member of the Canadian Country Music Hall of Fame.

CP Holiday Train stops in **Salmon Arm on December 14, 2019**. Arriving at 7:45 pm at 51 Lake Shore Dr. NE (Lordco gravel parking lot). Musical performance is from 8:00 to 8:30 pm.

CP Holiday Train stops in **Chase on December 15, 2019**. Arriving at 2:35 pm on the north side of Shuswap Ave (across from Chase RCMP building). Musical performance is from 2:45 to 3:15 pm.

CP Holiday Train event is free, they only ask that you bring healthy food donation or a monetary donation for your local food bank. Food bank representatives will be onsite collecting donations to support local families in need. Community residents welcome to come hear some great music while giving back to your community.

The CP Holiday Train has raised more than \$15.8 million and has collected 4.5 million pounds of food since its first journey in 1999.
