
Attention: Adams Lake Indian Band Hunters Elk Hunting Opportunities

The Alberta Environment and Parks (AEP), in partnership with Canada's Department of National Defense are providing elk hunting opportunities to our Community at Canadian Forces Base Suffield (CFB Suffield) approximately 50 km northwest of Medicine Hat, Alberta.

Two ALIB Member Hunters and their helpers (max of 2) interested in entering this draw are welcome to fill in *CFB Suffield First Nations Registration Form* (see attached). The dates that will be open this year are:

Week 1 - 20-22 Jan 2020 Week 2 - 27-29 Jan 2020 Week 3 - 3-5 Feb 2020

You **must be available** to go on the date you selected, and the meat must be shared with ALIB community freezer (50/50).

Please fill in the attached the registration form in full and email it back to Councillor Steven Teed at **StevenTeed@alib.ca** by Wed., September 25, 2019 1:00 pm. Selection process will be by a random draw of all applications received prior to the noted deadline. Draw will be done by ALIB Elder Group. The two hunting parties drawn; their applications will be forwarded onto Shuswap Nation Tribal Council (SNTC) office to send with all the Secwepemc Nation Applications. SNTC are providing a total of \$750 gas cards and 2 hotel rooms for 3 nights to be **split between** 2 hunting parties from each community. No other allowance or expenses will be covered.

*IMPORTANT:

- All successfully registered hunters must be checked in at the CFB Suffield Recreation Center Theater (located in Ralston, Alberta) between 6:00 am and 6:30 am. If not checked in at the registration table between those times you may lose your spot to someone else.
- Helpers cannot hunt. If helpers wish to hunt they must register as a hunter by filling in their own registration form and sending it in.
- <u>Everyone</u> entering the Military Range & Training Area must be 18 years old or older.
