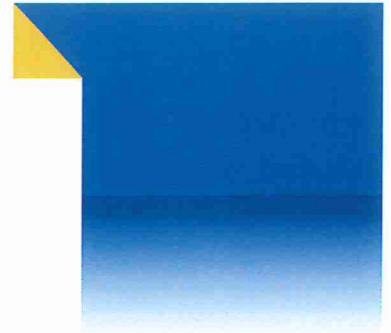


Notice to ALIB Members applying for Post Secondary Funds 2018/19



Adams Lake Band Education Department received approved allocation funding from AANDC (INAC) for Post Secondary 2018-19 funds based on:

- 1) Fully completed PSE Application & all required documents
 - 2) Those on the Priority List
 - 3) Have met AANDC/ALIB PSE criteria for receiving funds
- ◆ What does this mean? ALIB Education Dept submitted maximum PSE list and AANDC did not fund what we asked for. Therefore, not all PSE applications were approved and we based our decision on ALIB Post Secondary Policy & Priority List for PSE Funding for 2018-19.
 - ◆ For future PSE requests we will be asking high-school graduates and those members who want to apply for degrees, Masters, PHd - apply for as many scholarship, bursaries—the allocations we receive will not be able to fund all PSE requests based on priority list.
 - ◆ **All deadlines must be abided and followed**—Grade 12 students who have plans to attend Post Secondary Institute—start the paper work now—apply for scholarship, bursaries. Plan your education goals to ensure you have the requirements to get into the program you want. Can not wait until 1 or 2 months before program begins & expect approval for submission of PSE funds—ALIB Education department has deadlines we must meet to secure PSE funding.
 - ◆ Those on priority list don't have their PSE Application & required documents completed by the deadlines—other band members who are ready to go (PSE Application & required documents) will or may take your seat.
 - ◆ ALIB Education Department is partnering up with universities to bring programs to community ie: (ECE & Camp Cook/Professional) tuition is Free.

Our department will like to fund all ALIB members however, with limited funds we are unable to fill all requests. We will assist as much as possible to provide information for scholarships, bursaries, grants. Or make referrals to other agencies such as: ASETS, Income Assistance, Work BC, when seeking Education funds.
