Secwepemctsin 1 Stories Course Announcement



- An apprentice teacher/learner will assist in each class.
- A fluent Elder will be available on the Saturday classes to provide individual and group assistance.
- Students are expected to teach the stories to family and in community classes.
- This course will incorporate elements of Total Physical Response Storytelling, Communicative Based Learning as well as interactive and experiential activities.

Course Overview

- Participants receive Secwepemctsin 1 Stories resource binder with 7 illustrated stories and audios.
- Each lesson contains vocabulary terms and sentences incorporated into the stories.
- Lessons are interactive with individual and group practice activities.
- The focus is on communication: listening to the stories, asking and answering questions about the stories and re-telling the stories in Secwepemctsin.
- Homework for family practice will be assigned after each lesson and is expected to be completed before each class.
- Regular informal assessments will be given to monitor student progress. However, no marks will be assigned.
- No credits will be assigned.
- **Due to COVID 19, classes will be taught on an on-line platform such as Zoom, so access to Internet is required**
- **Pre-requisite: Completion of Secwepemctsin 1 or another beginner course in Secwepemctsin**
