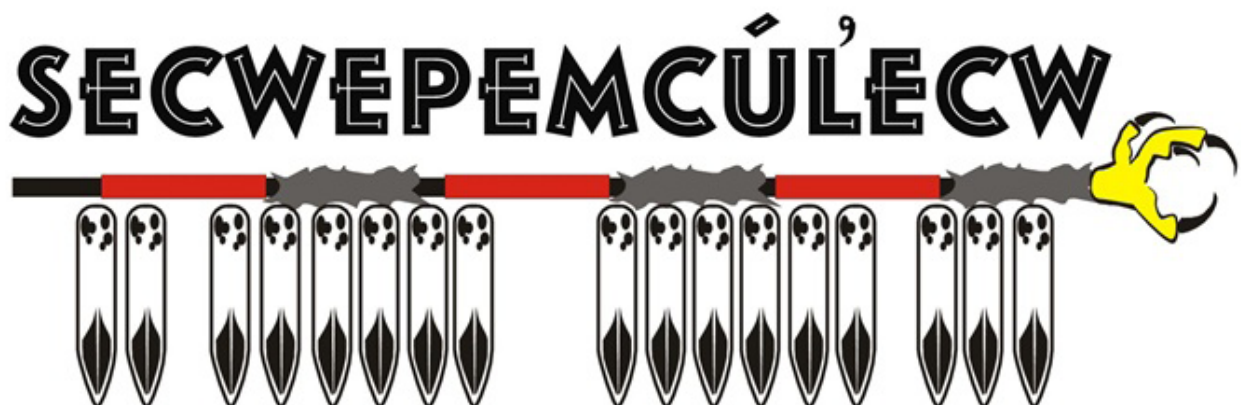
- Build Unity - *Find our common vision*
