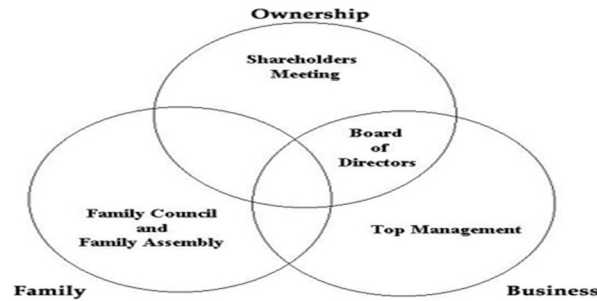

**WHAT IS TRADITIONAL GOVERNANCE?**

Let's start talking and meeting about it. We need a Title Declaration for the Sexqéltkemoc te Secwepemc Region (People of the Headwaters)

From SNTC Title and Rights Paper, June 2016:

“We explore ways people resolve conflicts and reach agreement respecting land & resources.... Community consultation is a core feature of decision making in which people affected by a problem or decision are given opportunity to contribute their voices. Families can provide reps in such deliberation so that leaders are NOT acting in isolation when making decisions on behalf of the community....in other cases the broader community is actively involved in specific tasks or actions can be given to individuals according to their ability...”

- Kwaselten – Family Heads – Canvassing families for their selection of their Spokesperson
- Kwaselten – give direction to the Leaders- make decisions
- Re-institute traditional leadership
- Salmon Chief, Hunting Chief, Root and Berry Gathering, Water Chief, Political Chiefs
