ALIB Community Safety Awareness Notice

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

February 26, 2020 (Chase, BC)

We are writing to make you aware of a concerning incident involving violence. This incident has resulted in physical injuries. We want to provide you with the following information so you can take the appropriate steps to protect yourself and others. ALIB Tkwekwem7iple support ALIB Security and RCMP increased presence.

Helpful safety tips and reporting suspicious activity:

- Stay together. Do not walk alone at night. Travel in groups and in well-lit areas.
- Be alert and trust your instincts. If it doesn't feel right, it probably isn't.
- Watch out for each other.
- Call 9-1-1 immediately if you or someone else is in danger.
- Report suspicious activity. Such as vehicles cruising at very slow speeds or people sitting in a vehicle for an extended period.
- Helpful observations/description details such as: make of vehicle (Ford, Honda), model (pick-up truck, Impala), Year (newer/older), colour of vehicle, license plate number and province, direction of travel, demographics of person(s), sex (male/female), race, age (young looking, middle, older), clothing, general appearance etc.
- If you have a paper and pen handy, write down the information.
