Adams Lake Indian Band - Beach Water Quality 2020

The public beaches are routinely monitored for water quality during the bathing season. Water samples are tested for E.coli bacteria, which is commonly found in feces of warm-blooded animals or human. The results are compare with Health Canada's Guidelines for Recreational Quality.

Current Beach Samples Results for 2020 (last 30 days):

Sandy Point Beach **Satisfactory** (samples taken over a 30 day period contain an average of Less Than or Equal to 200 E.coli bacteria/100ml.) Latest sample taken on June 24, 2020, meets the water quality standards.

Pierre's Point Beach **Satisfactory**. Latest sample taken on June 24, 2020, meets the water quality standards.

Glen Echo Beach **Satisfactory**. Latest sample taken on June 24, 2020, meets the water quality standards.

Indian Point Beach **Satisfactory**. Latest sample taken on June 4, 2020, meets the water quality standards.

No Beach Advisories are issued (as of June 29, 2020), water is suitable for recreational use.
