PRE-REGISTER FOR APPOINTMENT: All applicants must pre-register for an appointment within your Nation's time slot. If an applicant does not pre-register, you may have to wait or come back. WAITING AREA: MASKS MANDATORY. Signs will be posted to direct candidates to the pre-screening area that will be located outside the meeting room. Three (3) BCIB employees will be protected by mask and gloves. Lines on the ground will maintain a 2-metre distance. HEALTH SCREENING INTERVIEW: ALL candidates MUST complete a Health Screening Interview before entering the meeting room (questions attached). Candidates contact info will be taken for contact tracing. MEETING ROOM SANITIZED All candidates must sanitize their hands thoroughly before entering the meeting room. Social distance of 2 meters must be maintained at all times while in the meeting room (Chiefs Room). ENTERING THE MEETING ROOM Only 12 people will be allowed in the room at one time. The 'Chiefs Room' can hold up to 30 people safely while social distancing. A temperature check will be done (results will not be recorded) Candidates must answer all Covid-19 health screening questions (see attached) Candidates names & contact information will be taken for Contact Tracing Meeting room 'high touch points' (eg. door handles, tabletop areas) will be disinfected between appointments using disinfection wipes Plexiglass barriers will separate the applicant from the BCIB employee during the application process Masks are mandatory Seating will be 2 metres apart and separated by a plexiglass partition Applicants will share their information, certifications, experience & references to the BCIB employee BCIB will enter info to our on-line application
