September Reminders:

- Parents and caregivers must assess their child daily for symptoms of common cold, influenza, COVID-19, or other infectious respiratory disease before sending them to school.
 - If a child has any symptoms, they must not go to school.
- Routine wearing of masks by grade 3 students and up and staff within the school where physical distancing cannot be maintained is mandatory. Parents need to provide a reusable mask for their child(ren). The school will have disposable masks available. (Parents need to refer to the chief Atahm school reopening plan document that was emailed and put on facebook)
- 3. Children require indoor footwear.
- 4. Please provide your children with a nutritious lunch daily. The School provides emergency individually wrapped nutritious snacks when needed. We monitor lunches and give one warning for lunches with high sugar content and/or questionable nutritional value. You can help out by making healthy choices for your child(ren). Please remember the school is peanut free.

- Ensure your child(ren) are dressed appropriately for the weather.
 Nursery/Kindergarten students require a change of clothes for emergencies.
- 6. Students are not to bring any toys from home including electronic games.
- 7. Students require sufficient sleep.
- 8. Attendance: Parents must contact the school if your child will be absent.
- 9. Personal cell phone/ipod/ipad cannot be turned on during class hours.

BC School Fruit and Vegetable Nutritional Program

We are please to announce that Chief Atahm School has been accepted into the BC School Fruit and Vegetable Nutritional Program (Administered by the BC Agriculture in the Classroom Foundation and supported by healthy Families BC) for the 2020/2021 school year.

Our school is involved in a province-wide healthy living initiative. One of the goals is to encourage healthy eating by providing fresh BC fruits and vegetables to our students during class time. Our Students will receive these healthy treats 13 times over the school year at no charge.

Literacy

Parents are teachers: This year the school will continue the home reading program "Club Read", coordinated by Leanne Elynuik, Learning Assistant Teacher (LAT). Children bring home books (at their reading level) to read to their parents, from Monday to Thursday. If you want your child to join the program, call Leanne at the school. The school provides all books.

There are many activities that parents can do to encourage reading. Children should have "books of choice" to read. Parents can encourage reading by modeling reading...books, newspaper or e-readers. Parents can read to their child regularly. Helping your child read will give them a very valuable life long skill.

These are approximate times. Please have your child ready at least 5 or 10 minutes before. We will have the final bus route confirmed within 10 days of school.

Chief Atahm School Bus Reminders:

Chief Atahm School has a scheduled bus route with a set of pick up locations.

Parents need to confirm a regular pick up and drop off spot by completing the bus transportation form and handing in to the school

Parents are responsible for arranging their own transportation for their child when there are pick up/drop off changes that are not on the scheduled bus route (please phone the school if your child is not taking the scheduled bus route)

- Students and parents will be encouraged to consider alternate transportation to school (biking, walking, driving) when it is reasonable and safe to do so. If students need to travel by bus, parents and guardians will be asked to ensure that their children will abide by the following guidelines:
 - Perform hand hygiene before they leave home to take the bus, when they leave school prior to taking the bus, and when they get home.
 - Sit in their assigned seat (students will be assigned seats based on the order they are picked up and dropped off, loading back to front and offloading front to back).
 - Middle and secondary school students will wear a non-medical mask that is put on before loading and taken off after offloading, providing that they do not have a health condition that means they cannot tolerate a mask.

All parents that are requesting bus transportation for their child need to fill out the attached bus ridership form and complete and sign and hand back into the school.
