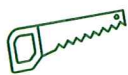

Interfor completed a four-year, \$140 million rebuild of Adams Lake

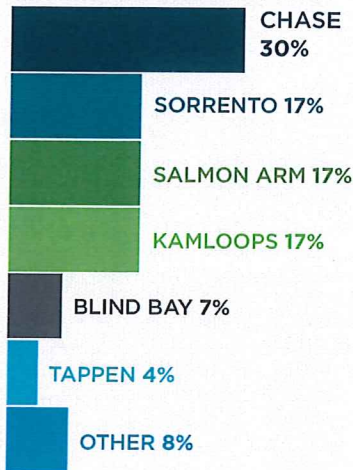

We produce a broad range of products from spruce-pine-fir (SPF), Douglas-fir, western red cedar, and hemlock. More than half of our products are **value-added specialty grade**.

Interfor's operations in British Columbia fall within the territories of more than 60 First Nations. We respect the deep connection First Nations have to their territories and work with them to develop strong relationships that offer mutual benefits.

First Nations play an integral role in the future of a strong, viable and sustainable forest economy in BC. Interfor is committed to seeking First Nations representation and participation in the forest industry and promoting socio-economic development opportunities across their communities.

SUSTAINABLE FORESTRY

Interfor is a leader in sustainable forestry, managing forest resources in a manner that is environmentally appropriate, socially beneficial and economically viable.

Interfor manages nearly 2.4 million hectares of forest on public lands in BC. **100% of our BC woodlands operations are third-party certified** to the globally recognized Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) 2015-2019 Forest Management Standard.
