Secwepemctsin 1 Songs and Supplementary Activities/Games Course



A fluent Elder will be available on Tuesdays and Thursdays classes to provide individual and group assistance.

Students are expected to teach the course to family and in community classes.

Games and songs will be provided for each lesson for engaging multigenerational practice.

Course Overview

- This class will be based on Secwepemctsín 1 Thematic Lessons 1 to 45. Most of the vocabulary will be from these lessons.
- The course will consist of songs, short booklets with questions and answers, and games on Secwepemctsin 1 lesson themes.
- Homework for family practice will be assigned after each lesson and is expected to be completed before each class.
- Regular informal assessments will be given to monitor student progress. However, no marks will be assigned.
- No credits will be assigned.
- Due to COVID 19, classes will be taught through videoconference on Bluejeans. Access to Internet is required.
