Wildfire Season 2021

Several wild fires are burning everywhere throughout the Province of BC. This season having low precipitation, thunderstorms delivering lightning and extreme heat, raised fire dangers to critical levels which resulted in several large fires.

Currently there are no wild fires that pose a threat to our communities IR 4&6.

The White Rock Lake wildfire (northern flank of the fire is about 13 km southeast of Pritchard) over the past 24 hours has had predominant fire growth and with predicted gusts of wind are expected next few days.

Households and families are urged to maintain heightened awareness of the evolving situation over the next 48 hours and are **asked to be prepared in advance**. Have a "To Go Bag" ready for each member of your family for any emergency that may occur.

Safety Tips

- Stay informed with trusted sources
- Monitor weather
- Keep your vehicle fueled
- Be prepared in case the need to evacuate
- Listen to local authorities.

Village of Chase, Neskonlith Indian Reserve #1

Both the Village of Chase and the Neskonlith Indian Band have issued Evacuation "ALERTS" because of the White Rock Lake fire. Both communities are being told to plan what they will do in the event of an evacuation order. Pack essential items and an emergency kit.

Water Restriction Update for IR #4 and IR #1

The water level in our reservoirs have moved to acceptable levels. Residents with even numbered addresses can only water on even numbered days while those with odd numbered addresses to water on odd numbered days. Water lawns in the evening after 6 pm.

IR #4 Irrigation System is now operational.
