S100/S185 - Fire Suppression

- S100 Under the Wildfire Act, workers must be trained and certified in fire suppression techniques. This course is designed to meet the training requirements for those who work in the forests of British Columbia and meet the training requirements of the Wildfire Act and accompanying regulations for people temporarily hired by the BC Ministry of Forests.
- S185 provides students with a greater awareness on identifying and avoiding potentially dangerous situations while working as a wildland firefighter.
- 14 hours, mix of theory and hands on skill
